### Our Favourite things to do in Oxfordshire

#### Take an Open Air Bus Tour

On the tour you will see Magdalen College, The site of William Morris's first workshop, University Science Area, the City Walls, Sheldonian Theatre, Ashmolean Museum, Martyr's Memorial, Christ Church College, River Cherwell, Carfax Tower, Alice's Shop, Radcliffe Infirmary, Bodleian Library, The High, Broad Street and the University Parks.

The tour also stops at various points for visits to University Colleges, Museums, Shops, Restaurants and The Botanic Garden.

#### Visit Tolkien's Grave

Tolkien's Grave – Wolvercote Cemetery

Directly opposite the guesthouse you will find Wolvercote Cemetery, the final resting place of J. R. R. Tolkein

Tolkien died in 1973 while on holiday in Bournemouth. He was buried here, with his wife, in the Wolvercote Cemetery in North Oxford. On the grave stone it says:

Home of the 11th Duke and Duchess of Marlborough and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill stands in spectacular formal gardens created by the famed English landscaper Capability Brown. Other highlights include fishing on Blenheim Lake, the miniature train ride to the pleasure gardens with its maze and playground, and the butterfly house.
